HIGHWAY 13 (PHASE 1) WATER AND
SEWER IMPROVEMENTS**

TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

Notice is hereby given that the City Council of the City of Waterville is conducting a Public Hearing on Assessments for Highway 13 (phase 1) water and sewer improvements.

The City Council of Waterville, Minnesota, will meet in the Council Chambers, 200 Third Street South, in the City of Waterville, Minnesota, on the 2nd day of April, 2019, at 6:00 P.M. to consider objections to the proposed assessments for the Highway 13 (phase 1) water and sewer improvements heretofore ordered by the City Council.

ASSESSMENT ROLL: The proposed assessment roll is on file with the City Clerk and open to public inspection.

AREA PROPOSED TO BE ASSESSED: The area proposed to be assessed consists of every lot, piece or parcel of land benefited by said improvement, which has been ordered made and is as follows: water and sewer improvements on Highway 13 North from North Reed Street and ending at address 1280 State Hwy 13 North in the City

TOTAL AMOUNT AND TERM OF PROPOSED ASSESSMENT: The total amount proposed to be assessed is \$192,277.67 and is proposed to be payable in annual installments over a period of 10 years with an interest rate of 3%.

WRITTEN OR ORAL OBJECTIONS: Written or oral objections will be considered at the hearing.

RIGHT OF APPEAL: An owner of property to be assessed may appeal the assessment to the district court of Le Sueur County pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, Section 429.081 by serving notice of the appeal upon the Mayor or Clerk of the City within 30 days after the adoption of the assessment and filing such notice with the district court within ten days after service upon the Mayor or Clerk.

LIMITATION ON APPEAL: No appeal may be taken as to the amount of any assessment adopted by the City Council unless a written objection signed by the affected property owner is filed with the Clerk prior to the assessment hearing or presented to the presiding officer at the hearing. All objections to the assessments not received at the assessment hearing in the manner prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, Section 429.061 are waived, unless the failure to object at the assessment hearing is due to a reasonable cause.

DEFERMENT OF ASSESSMENTS: Under the provisions of Minnesota Statutes, Sections 435.193 to 435.195, the City may, at its discretion, defer the payment of assessments for any homestead property owned by a person 65 years of age or older for whom it would be a hardship to make the payments. Also Under the provisions of Minnesota Statutes, the City may defer the payment of assessments under the Unimproved Property Provision.

MAILED NOTICE: The notice of this hearing mailed to property owners contains additional information.
