1. Beginning in 2018, voters in Kilkenny City in Le Sueur County will vote entirely by mail in statewide elections as authorized by the township/city under MN Statutes 204B.45.

2. For 2018 statewide elections, the election dates and the corresponding dates that ballots will be mailed to all registered voters in mail ballot precincts are:

Statewide Primary Election: August 14, 2018

Ballot Mailing Dates: June 29 - July 31, 2018

Statewide General Election: November 6, 2018

Ballot Mailing Dates: September 21, 2018 - October 23, 2018

Each voter registered by July 24, 2018 for the Statewide Primary, and/or October 16, 2018 for the Statewide General Election will be mailed a ballot automatically.

3. Eligible voters not pre-registered by the dates noted, or pre-registered voters wishing to receive their ballot at a temporary address may contact the Le Sueur County Elections Office by phone, mail or in person for an absentee ballot application.

4. All ballots may be returned by mail (a postage prepaid return envelope is included when the ballots are mailed), or may be delivered in person, or delivered by a designated agent to:

NOTICE OF HEARING ON ASSESSMENTS FOR THE BUCHANNON STREET AND DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENTS OF 2018

TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

Notice is hereby given that the City Council of the City of Waterville is conducting a Public hearing on Assessments for the Buchannon Street and Drainage Improvements of 2018.

The City Council of Waterville, Minnesota, will meet in the Council Chambers, 200 Third Street South, in the City of Waterville, Minnesota, on the 5th day of June, 2018, at 6:00 P.M. to consider objections to the proposed assessments for the Buchannon Street and Drainage Improvements of 2018 heretofore ordered by the City Council.

ASSESSMENT ROLL: The proposed assessment roll is on file with the City Clerk and open to public inspection.

AREA PROPOSED TO BE ASSESSED: The area proposed to be assessed consists of every lot, piece or parcel of land benefited by said improvement, which has been ordered made and is as follows: Street and Drainage improvements on the following street: Buchannon Street from River to the Cannon River.

TOTAL AMOUNT AND TERM OF PROPOSED ASSESSMENT: The total amount proposed to be assessed is \$28,156.62 and is proposed to be payable in annual installments over a period of 10 years with an interest rate of 3%.

WRITTEN OR ORAL OBJECTIONS: Written or oral objections will be considered at the hearing.

RIGHT OF APPEAL: An owner of property to be assessed may appeal the assessment to the district court of Le Sueur County pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, Section 429.081 by serving notice of the appeal upon the Mayor or Clerk of the City within 30 days after the adoption of the assessment and filing such notice with the district court within ten days after service upon the Mayor or Clerk.

LIMITATION ON APPEAL: No appeal may be taken as to the amount of any assessment adopted by the City Council unless a written objection signed by the affected property owner is filed with the Clerk prior to the assessment hearing or presented to the presiding officer at the hearing. All objections to the assessments not received at the assessment hearing in the manner prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, Section 429.061 are waived, unless the failure to object at the assessment hearing is due to a reasonable cause.

DEFERMENT OF ASSESSMENTS: Under the provisions of Minnesota Statutes, Sections 435.193 to 435.195, the City may, at its discretion, defer the payment of assessments for any homestead property owned by a person 65 years of age or older for whom it would be a hardship to make the payments. Also Under the provisions of Minnesota Statutes, the City may defer the payment of assessments under the Green Acres Provision.
